I thought I would send you a quick email to say thank you for the invite and sorry I am unable to attend.

As you are aware I took over as the Beat Manager for Harleston on the 15th of February 2017 after returning from maternity leave and am now working part-time which means I do four out of the six shifts each set.

Unfortunately PCSO Williamson will be leaving and moving onto a new role in the Early Help Hub based at the South Norfolk Council Offices as of 27th of April. I will be sad to see him go and at the moment there is no plans to replace him.

I have been a Police Officer for ten years and have worked seven of those ten years in South Norfolk mainly covering Harleston area as a response officer and the other three years working in Norwich.

The way that the Beat Mangers are now working is based on three monthly street surgeries, I did my first Street Surgery on Wednesday 8th of March at Budgens. During the surgery I had a small questionnaire that I asked members of the public to complete, this gave me the main concerns, areas of concern and thoughts on Police. The answers then give me the priorities that I work on for the next three months until the next surgery, it also gives me the top five speeding locations to monitor.

The surgery gave these priorities :-

- Drugs on the recreation ground and also on Bugens Car park
- Speeding in around Harleston
- Anti social behaviour on the recreation ground.

I am aware that these are all in Harleston but doesn't not mean I wont be patrolling Pulham and the other villages and dealing with any issues that come to light.
