

Monthly Report for Pulham St Mary Parish Council Meeting

The Councillors of Pulham St Mary Parish Council met for the Monthly Parish Council Meeting on the 10th December 2019 at The Pennoyer Centre. The meeting commenced at 7.30 pm. Report as follows;

- Apologies were accepted from Cllrs Hudson, West, Buridge and Langshaw. Cllr Albon chaired the meeting.
- Declaration of interest were received on agenda items relating to the Pennoyer's and the parish website.
- Minutes of the November meeting were agreed and signed as a correct record.
- All news items and records have been updated on the parish website.
- The fingerpost sign refurbishment project, Community Infrastructure Levy, funded projects and conservation area appraisal are all ongoing.

Reports

The Chairman/District Cllr Hudson provided a report, identifying VE day grants up to £200.00, currently available from South Norfolk Council, for events/activities held between 8 & 10th May 2020 to mark the 75th anniversary of the end of the Second World War. This item will be included on the January agenda

Cllr Albon reported on the meeting with Sargent Butler and PC Phillips. Council are concerned on the cost from the parish precept, to repair assets damaged through vandalism. The council are therefore working with the safer neighbourhood team to monitor/manage the recent low level anti-social behavior in the village. - Cllr Scanlan and Albon updated council on the install of the new bin and repair to the second bin, gate and 'No Dog' signage at North Green Play area. Safety fencing will be replaced around the roundabout site, following previous vandalism but infilling of the safety matting will be postponed until after the install of the new equipment.
- Council perused the draft budget for 2020/21, this matter will be considered at the January meeting when precept request for 2020/21 will be ratified.
