The **Playpark** is now complete with new apparatus installed; we now have a wonderful facility for families to enjoy. Sadly, some anti-social behaviour has taken place on the playpark and the local police/community officer are involved. The equipment in question will be replaced shortly.

We have 4 flower **planters** in the village with bulbs and annual plants for you to enjoy, hopefully a maintenance team can look after them.

Our newly installed **bus shelter** was damaged just after a few weeks of installation, it is going to be replaced under our insurance with a like for like unit with solar lighting and reflective strips to appear move visible to avoid any future damage.

South Green Recreational Field is now being used for Youth Football with many plans in place for the future from International Talent Football Club. Man Shed will also be active on South Green with plans already submitted.

Potholes have been attended to, please report any others that need attention.

The local **bus timetable** has been increased this year with more buses available, it is great to see the bus service being used.

Footpaths have been regularly checked, and footbridges are being replaced is needed. Plans for an extra kissing-gate have been agreed and will be installed in the coming months.

Our **local shop** has been refurbished, and well stocked. We welcome the new owners to the village.
